Course Objectives

- This is a clinical and problem-oriented ECG & Arrhythmia course.
- Participants will refresh reporting of normal ECG in neonates and children (pre-course reading/ECG Basics e-Learning) – the course as such will focus on ECG beyond the basics.
- Participants will achieve an understanding of the recognition and management of SVT, VT, ectopics and heart blocks.
- Participants will update on investigations in the context of suspected cardiomyopathies and congenital heart disease.
- Participants will be able to recognise and manage a range of abnormal ECGs including Long QT and medication use.
- Participants will revise the ECG diagnosis of pulmonary hypertension, pericarditis, myocarditis, electrolyte disturbances etc
